Minimum Submittal Requirements

The following documents are required in order to obtain a Fence Permit.

1. Completed Fence Permit Application.
2. A site plan showing the location of the fence consisting of either:
 - a. Fence Installation Plan, or,
 - b. Single Family Site Plan (SFSP) in lieu of the Fence Installation Plan.
3. Pool Permit (if applicable).

Required Fence Location Plan Items

Provide all items listed below. If not applicable, applicant shall note on this checklist. An incomplete application will not be accepted into the review process.

General Requirements

- ___ 1. Three (3) copies of the Fence Location Plan.
- ___ 2. Submittal fee and completed application.

Plan Requirements

Per Section 4.11 of the Sandy Springs Zoning Ordinance.

- ___ 1. Maximum sheet size shall be 24" x 36" (min. font size of 0.08).
- ___ 2. Project name and address, subdivision name and lot number (if applicable), landlot, district and zoning.
- ___ 3. Owner's name and complete address including zip code.
- ___ 4. Scale of drawing (1"=10 to 1"=40').
- ___ 5. Street name and boundary information including bearings and distances along all property lines.
- ___ 6. Lot building setback lines (per Sandy Springs Zoning Ordinance) labeled with dimensions to lot lines.
- ___ 7. Locations of all existing structures (including houses, barns, sheds, landscape and retaining walls, sanitary and storm drainage lines and structures, detention ponds and structures, septic tanks and lines, pools, fences, etc.) with distances to lot lines for all above ground structures.
- ___ 8. Location of zoning buffers, access easements, sewer easements, drainage easements, etc.
- ___ 9. Location of any City of Sandy Springs tributary buffers and/or state water buffers, if applicable.

Utilities and Other Structures (Not Including the House)

- ___ 1. If a pool is proposed, the location of the pool must be shown. Provide dimensions relating the pool to the fence. **(Note: a Pool Permit will be required prior to SFSP and/or Fence Permit approval).**

Trees

- ___ 1. Location of any specimen trees. A specimen tree is any deciduous tree with a diameter at breast height (DBH) of 27 inches and larger, or a coniferous tree with a DBH of 24 inches and larger.
- ___ 2. Location of all landscape strips and tree save areas.
- ___ 3. Arborist approval required.

Pool Fencing Requirements

Per Section 4.11 of the Sandy Springs Zoning Ordinance.

- ___ 1. Permanent fencing and gated enclosures are required for all pools in the city.
- ___ 2. Fence design shall not produce a "ladder" effect that could aid in unauthorized climbing.
- ___ 3. Pool fences must include at least one gated exit with a minimum width of 36" wide. This exit must open outward and be self closing and self latching.
- ___ 4. The minimum height of the fence must be five (5) feet, and the maximum height of this fence shall not exceed eight (8) feet.
- ___ 5. Fences and walls used as fences, may not be finished with bright or primary colors. If only one side of the fence is to be finished, the fence shall be constructed with the finished side toward the neighboring property.
